Mission Resources Grant Application

In late October, the Vestry submitted a grant application to the Diocese of Bethlehem. If granted, St. Luke's would be able to enhance its live streaming with new cameras and an audio system. Until now, we have been streaming via an android phone positioned on a tripod. The microphones in those androids are not designed to capture quality sound and so what we stream is muffled and unintelligible. With the limited phone camera, priests and readers are restricted in their movements in order to stay within range of the stationary lens. However, if the diocese grants our request we would have the funds necessary to purchase the technology and train parishioners who have expressed an interest in serving in this important parish ministry. Until that time, St. Luke's will pause live streaming until further notice.
